

## **By Train & Bus**

**Haddenham/Thame Parkway** is the nearest railway station to the venue, approx 2 miles. The station is on the Chiltern Line and direct trains come in from London Marylebone or Birmingham Moor Street (Few minutes walk from Birmingham New Street).

There is a taxi service right next to the station or alternatively there is a bus stop with frequent buses (every ½ hour) to Thame.

*Arriva 280. You will need to catch the bus that says “280 Oxford” when going to Thame and catch the “280 Aylesbury” when returning to the station. The bus stops directly outside Thame Leisure Centre, when boarding the bus tell the driver that you want to Thame Leisure Centre & sit near the front of the bus. Please note that the bus goes through the town centre first and the Leisure Centre is on the outskirts as you go out of Thame on the bus route.*

**Oxford Station** – has the 280 Arriva bus stop directly outside the station and is the beginning of the terminus. You need to catch the “280 Aylesbury” bus. They are ½ hourly and the journey takes approx 50 mins to Thame from here. The bus stops directly outside the Leisure Centre, please note that the Leisure Centre is the first stop on the outskirts of Thame itself. So as you approach Thame get ready to ring that bell! Going back to Oxford Station ensure you catch the “280 Oxford” bus and as stated before, Oxford Station is the end of the terminus.
