

## Directions

PLEASE NOTE THAT DUE TO LOCAL COUNCIL RESTRICTIONS WE ARE UNABLE TO PLACE ANY SIGNAGE TO OUR EVENT IN THE TOWN OR THE SURROUNDING AREA ON THE DAY OF THE EVENT. THE ONLY SIGNAGE WE ARE ALLOWED IS DIRECTLY OUTSIDE THE LEISURE CENTRE.

### **By Car**

*NB All these directions have been given in good faith, however if you get lost in Thame just ask someone the directions to Thame Leisure Centre in Oxford Road, someone is bound to know (providing you get as far as Thame of course)!*

**\*If you are coming from London end of M40** it is easier (but a little longer) to take junction 7. Turn right at the slip road, then straight along the A329. Eventually you will come to a main roundabout, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit off into Oxford Road and after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to a 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

*A much quicker but less direct route is the following:*

**\*If you are coming from London end of M40**, take junction 6. Right off the slip road onto B4009 then left onto A40. Travel through Postcombe, then once through village, on the right take B4012 all the way to Thame. As you come into Thame on the Thame Park Road, you will come to a T-junction. Take left (opposite garage) and travel along Park Street. Straight over the next 4 mini roundabouts, past Six Bells Pub (on the left) & you should now be in Lower High Street. Follow road around sharp bend now you are into Oxford Road. Travel straight on, past Lord Williams Upper School, then directly after school on the left is the Leisure Centre.

**\* If you are coming from Birmingham end of M40**, take junction 8 (services) sign posted Thame. Off the slip road go straight over the roundabout (first exit) *NOT the golf course- is misleading*, following signs A418 to Thame. As you travel through Tiddington, keep to 30mph as there is speed camera. Eventually you will come to large roundabout. Travel straight over into Thame, this is Oxford Road and after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to another 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

**\* If you are coming from Oxford on the A40/M40**, take junction 8a (sign posted Thame). Off the slip road turn left. Travel straight over 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> roundabout, following signs to Thame on A418. As you travel through Tiddington, keep to 30mph as there is speed camera. Eventually you will come to large roundabout. Travel straight over into Thame, this is Oxford Road and after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to another 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

**\*If you approach Thame from Aylesbury on the A418**, on the first main roundabout, take the third exit (straight on really) and travel along this by-pass to next large roundabout. Take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit (left) into Oxford Road, after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to a 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

**Continued on reverse.....**

**\*If you approach Thame from Bicester/Long Crendon on the B4011**, as you come to the first main roundabout, take the 4<sup>th</sup> exit off and travel along this by-pass to next large roundabout. Take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit (left) into Oxford Road, after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to a 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

**\*If you approach Thame from Longwick end on A4129**, rather than travel through the town, take the 3<sup>rd</sup> exit off small roundabout, along the bypass. When you come to the main roundabout, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit off. Travel along this bypass and at next large roundabout, take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit (left) into Oxford Road, after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to a 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).

**\* If you approach Thame from Chinnor on the B4445**, rather than travel through the town take 3<sup>rd</sup> exit off (right) mini roundabout, straight over next roundabout, travel along the bypass. When you come to the main roundabout, take the 2<sup>nd</sup> exit off along this bypass, to next large roundabout. Take the 1<sup>st</sup> exit (left) into Oxford Road, after a few yards on the right hand side you will see Thame Leisure Centre (if you get to a 30mph speed camera you have missed the leisure centre).
